Man mortal and perishing, NOT an immortal soul.

The dead unconscious, NOT alive in hell or heaven.

Hell (Heb: sheol; Greek: hades) the grave, NOT eternal torment. Genesis 37:35; Job 14:13; 1 Corinthians 15:55

The devil a personification of sin, NOT a person.

Romans 5:21; 8:3; 1 Corinthians 15:56; Galatians 5:19-20; Hebrews 2:14; James 1:14-15

Resurrection at the last day, NOT hell or heaven at death.

Daniel 12:2; 1 Corinthians 15:21-23; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

Resurrection for the responsible only, NOT all mankind.

Psalm 49:12, 20; Proverbs 21:16; Isaiah 26:13-14; Jeremiah 51:39

Judgment and reward when Christ returns, NOT at death.

Earth the reward of the righteous, NOT heaven.

Complete destruction for the wicked, NOT eternal torment.

The majority have always been wrong, NOT right.

Faithful obedience required, NOT 'faith without works'.

ONE God, NOT three—the trinity an invention of man.

Baptism essential AFTER belief, NOT at birth. John 3:5; Acts 2:38; Romans 6:3-5; Galatians 3:27; 1 Peter 3:21

Total immersion in water, NOT man's invention of sprinkling. Matthew 3:6; John 3:23; Acts 8:38; Romans 6:4; Colossians 2:12
